

## Application Instructions for WIOA Training Services

In order to be considered for Training Services through CareerSource Research Coast (CSRC), you must be fully registered in **Employ Florida** (<u>www.employflorida.com</u>) to include your work history, educational background, and resume.

Funding may be available for programs and educational institutions listed on our **Eligible Training Provider List**, which is located here: <u>https://careersourcerc.com/job-seekers/job-</u> <u>seeker-resources/training-opportunities/</u> (<u>Note</u>: After clicking on this link or copying/pasting it into your internet browser, you will need to scroll down & <u>click on</u> "Eligible Training Provider" *List* under the *Approved Training Program List* heading).

## Application Steps:

- 1. Please register in the Employ Florida system (<u>www.employflorida.com</u>) to establish a User ID and Password. Assistance in completing an Employ Florida registration is available at our Career Centers.

- 3. The Training Interest Form is a Google Document and will be transmitted to our office. A staff member will contact you within two business days.
- 4. You will be assigned a Career Planner. If you appear to meet eligibility and suitability requirements to apply for a Workforce Innovation & Opportunity Act (WIOA) training grant, the Career Planner will schedule an appointment with you to complete an intake/grant application. You will need to gather the required documents and bring them to your scheduled appointment or submit them electronically prior to your appointment.
- 5. Applicants will be considered on a funds-available basis, using *Priority of Service*. Veterans and their eligible spouses continue to have priority of service for WIOA, and other designated job-training programs funded in whole or in part by the U.S. Department of Labor. Refer to *Administrator's Memo 10-2, Implementation of Priority of Service for Veterans and Eligible Spouses*, for further information on this requirement. Under WIOA, individualized career services and training services have a given priority, regardless of funding levels, with priority given to the following: Public assistance recipients; Low-income adults; and/or Individuals who are basic-skills deficient.

\*Please complete all steps above <u>at least</u> 3 to 4 weeks prior to your projected start date of classes/training, as all requests must be scheduled for review by a committee prior to approval for funding.
